



Regional Interleague Challenger KO Cup Format

- 12 Teams (11 players per team maximum)
- 2 from each county from: Champions, Runner-up, KO Cup Winner or Runner Up
- Event to be KO Cup Format
- All matches to be completed in one day
- Venue rotates around the Region, year on year. (Kent in 2010, Berks in 2011, Hampshire in 2012)
- Matches of Eighteen frames (all frames played)
- 4 groups of three: Drawn on the day (Teams from the same county to be kept apart)

Group Stage

Match 1 Team A v Team B
Match 2 Loser in Match 1 v Team C
Match 3 Winner in Match 1 v Team C

Groups Results to be sorted by

1. Match Won
2. Frame Difference
3. Result between the two sides
4. Three Frame Play-off if still tie
(for Play-off, please ensure all three frames are to break at the same time)

Semis: Winner of Group A v Winner of Group B
 Winner of Group C v Winner of Group D

Final: Semi 1 v Semi 2

Fees & Funds

£50 entry per team (this is to be paid before the event and non refundable. Organiser of this event needs to check with Regional Secretary on the morning of the event to see if there's any bad/bounced payment)

£700 prize (£600 from entry plus £100 from hosting venue sponsor)

Whoever pays the entry get the prize: Team, League, County..etc)

Winner £400

RunnerUp £200

Semi Final Teams £50 (per team)

Perpetual Winners & Runner Up Trophies to be supplied (That remains the property of Region Seven at all times, any damages or lost will be the responsibility of the team(s) who possess these trophies at the time).

Players must have played 50% of the County Interleague & Local League structure (as per EPA rules) (Evident need to be submitted to the Regional Secretary in good time [normally same time as submitting entry fees] for checking prior to the event. Fail to do so will result the offending team not able to play on the day)
